

APF Youth Competition: Details and Guidelines

The APF Youth Competition is part of the Augusta Photo Festival and is open to students in grades 6-12. The Augusta Photo Festival will take place June 11-20, 2010.

Important Dates

- **Deadline for entries in the APF Youth Competition: Friday, April 30, 2010.**
- **Exhibition dates: June 1– 27, 2010.**
- The APF Youth Competition Reception will be held at the Gertrude Herbert Institute of Art (506 Telfair Street, Augusta, Georgia 30901) on **Sunday, June 13, 2010 at 2:00 pm.**
- Photographs may be picked up at the Augusta-Richmond County Public Library after July 15, 2010. All entries must be picked up by September 1, 2010, or they will be discarded.

Rules

- Only those in grades 6-12 grades may enter.
- The subject of entries is open, and may include, but is not limited to: people, places, nature, abstracts, etc. Content Advisory: Photos with offensive imagery and/or messages or those that violate or infringe upon copyright will not be accepted.
- **Limit of 2 entries per person.**
- A hard copy **and** a digital copy must be submitted for each entry.
- Prints should be matted or mounted and be no larger than 11x14 before mounting.
- Prints submitted without being mounted or matted will not be displayed.
- Each hard copy entry must be submitted with an entry form which can be printed out from www.augustaphotofestival.org or from www.ecgrl.org.
- Film entries may also be submitted, but must be scanned into a digital format to qualify.
- The digital copies must be turned in on CD. CDs must be labeled with your name & phone number.
- Digital copies must be in *.jpg* format.

Judging

- Judging will be conducted by persons qualified in the fine art of photography, as chosen by the APF.
- The entries will be separated into two age categories: Middle School (6-8 grades) and High School (9-12 grades) for judging purposes.
- All photos entered into the competition will be displayed (subject to available gallery space), and all entrants will receive a certificate of participation.
- The winners of the top 3 photos in each age category, as determined by the APF judges, will receive a cash prize (\$50 – First Place, \$25 – Second Place, and \$15 – Third Place), a free student membership to the Gertrude Herbert Institute of Art, and a Morris Museum Family Membership. Winners may receive additional prizes, as available.
- Winning photos will be published on the Festival’s website and exhibited in various galleries throughout the Augusta area and will include various forms of print and digital publication.

Use of Photographs

By entering the contest, entrants grant The Augusta Photography Festival a royalty-free, world-wide, perpetual, non-exclusive license to display, distribute, reproduce, and create derivative works of the entries, in whole or in part, in any media now existing or subsequently developed, for any Festival purpose, including, but not limited to advertising and promotion of the Festival and its website, exhibition, and commercial products. Photographs may appear on the Festival’s website as well as in various publications that feature the Festival. Any photograph reproduced will include a photographer credit. The Augusta Photography Festival will not be required to pay any additional consideration or seek any additional approval in connection with such uses. The Augusta Photography Festival is not responsible for loss or damage to photographs entered into the competition.
